**Join Renewal for an hour of praise and worship at 9 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 10, in Mabee Chapel.** All are invited.

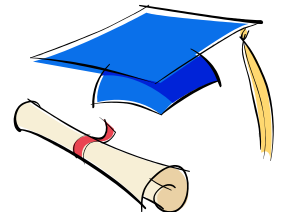

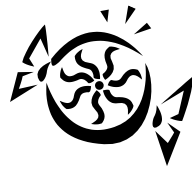
**Students in the English Club and Honor Society are now accepting book donations for the third annual Book and Bake Sale, which will be held Feb. 12, 15-18.**
